



## Saxon-Meiningian municipal office Wöhlisdorf near Saalfeld / Saale in the Duchy of Saxony-Meiningen

Ceremonial proclamation of the reactivation and reactivation certificate (foundation certificate) as well as judicial elaboration on the legal and constitutional situation

This oath of truth before God and before creation is pronounced aloud and witnessed with a visible show of hands of the consent of all people present, taken and made known to everyone as a public record.

Today, the fifth of July two thousand and twenty-three = July 5, 2023 = we = the autographing indignates below = are reactivating the saxon-meiningian municipal office of Wöhlisdorf near Saalfeld / Saale out of the power of our hearts and free will.

The municipal office of Wöhlisdorf near Saalfeld/Saale, which has hereby been legally restored, is located in the continuing state of Saxony-Meiningen, which has never been legally dissolved and has now been reactivated again via the Saxony-Meiningen community of Wöhlisdorf.

Despite newer Thuringian and German constitutions and due to the ongoing coup, the original Saxon-Meiningian constitution of August 23, 1829 with its legal developments until July 30, 1914 applies in any case.

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In all commercial and non-commercial matters, the pan-German legal situation should be recognized with the genuine state German law and with the constitution of April 16, 1871 as well as the Kingdom of Prussia which has since then unfortunately been illegally overlaid, with its constitution and the associated general land law for Prussian states of June 1, 1794 and be applied.

This is all the more so since most local people unfortunately do not refer to the newer Allied guidelines and imperial legal regulations as well as available constitutions.

Instead, out of convenience and/or lack of understanding, many people run after the illegal system of the extensive economic area called the Federal Republic of Germany [FRG] and the European Union [EU], which is organized purely in commercial law and was suspended by the Allies on July 17, 1990 at the latest.

Many also do not notice that it is primarily engaged in bankruptcy administration and bankruptcy cover-up, despite the public announcements of the first truly German post-war government = the Commissar's Reich Government = and the Allied-approved Plenipotentiary General and Reich Chancellor Dr. hc. jur. Wolfgang Gerhard Günter Ebel from 1987 until its virtual collapse in 2014/2015, the three purification laws, the DPE-ACC regulations, the dissolution of the various Vatican bulls Romanus Pontifex of June 21, 2011, the Aeterni Regis and the Motu Proprio des Pope of July 11, 2013.

Unfortunately many people still follow the illegal system called the Federal Republic of Germany and the European Union [FRG-EU for short], which is organized purely in terms of commercial law, out of convenience and lack of understanding.

The system [FRG-EU] has very similar names and companies such as "Federal State Free State of Thuringia",

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„but with the “administrative headquarters” in Erfurt instead of like the true State of Saxony-Meiningen and Reichsland Free State Thuringia with the old and true parliamentary seat in Weimar”, organized and exposed as a purely commercial company system.

The duchy and federal state of Saxony-Meiningen, the Kingdom of Prussia and the federation of states of the 2nd German Empire, which apparently never actually disappeared and therefore remain legitimate, serve as the basis and important element for both the reactivation of the community of Wöhlsdorf near Saalfeld /Saale as well as for the revival or Continuation and transfer of all local conditions and people back to the true homeland of Saxony-Meiningen.

The reactivation of all constitutional federal States by the man Ulrich I in collaboration with Dagmar Sybille from the Tietzsch family, approved by the Allied side, between September 23, 2017 and September 15, 2020, was carried out by the Reich Court and was based on the Kingdom of Prussia and its land law of the Prussian states from September 1st, June 1974 should also be mentioned and acknowledged here with regard to the state and state law applicable to Saxony-Meiningen. 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**The force and legal effect of this declaration of intent arise**

With this sovereign act, the municipality of Wöhlisdorf near Saalfeld / Saale in the federal state of Saxony-Meiningen and the Reichsland Freistaat Thüringia is activated into the ability to act with the valid constitutional law.

Our reactivated community of Wöhlisdorf and the federal state and duchy of Saxon-Meiningen naturally stand by the legitimate state and kingdom of Prussia.

Since then, the legitimate Prussia has also been overlaid, changed, supposedly dissolved and put away in a variety of ways.

The Prussians and the literature speak of the multiple Prussian blows, which we of course vehemently reject and regret.

The "civil death" of people, which is repeatedly brought about by the criminal Vatican and other dark powers, among other things by means of a "legal person" and birth certificate, is prohibited here in Wöhlisdorf and in the state of Saxony-Meiningen.

We continue to place our fate and trust in God's hands and of course also recognize the prophet, messiah and heart of God Zahid Ali Khan, who comes from Lahore / Pakistan and was sent to us by God in Germany. 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## Brief review of Wöhlisdorf's history as well as the duchy and state of Saxony-Meiningen

The small community or village of Wöhlisdorf is located to the left of the Saale on federal highway 85 in the Saale floodplain. The nearby neighboring town is Crösten. Beulwitz then follows seamlessly. These locations are located in the rural area of the Saale city of Saalfeld/Saale.

The district's soils are fertile and close to groundwater.

The small community of Wöhlisdorf (Alma-Weidatal) with around 66 souls was first mentioned in a document in 1389.

A battle between 9,000 Prussian and 14,000 French soldiers took place near Wöhlisdorf on October 10, 1806. The French force won. In this battle, the commander of the vanguard, the Prussian Prince Louis Ferdinand of Prussia, was killed.

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There is a monument to Prince Louis Ferdinand of Prussia in Wöhlisdorf. It was built between 1821 and 1823 based on a design by Karl Friedrich: Sch i n f e l. Between 1981 and 1984 the monument was demolished and then rebuilt. The steel-like structure made of sandstone has a triangular gable. There is a bronze relief with a standing genius by Christian Friedrich: T i e l embedded in it.

The place is still strongly agriculturally oriented today and is surrounded by fields, agricultural paths and the large Saale meadows along the Saale, which is not far away.

The prevailing Federal Republic-GU system views Wöhlisdorf as a "location of the Beulwitz district" of the city of Saalfeld/Saale in the Saalfeld-Rudolstadt district in Thuringia. However, this approach cannot be understood or agreed to from a purely legal point of view. There were never any legally binding incorporations, so Wöhlisdorf is still an independent municipality.

There are also other communities or villages with the same name called Wöhlisdorf throughout Thuringia, which is why people also speak of Wöhlisdorf near Saalfeld / Saale.

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## On the Duchy and State of Saxony-Meiningen

The Duchy and the federal state of Saxony-Meiningen as well as Thuringia were recently divided into the "eternal alliance" called the German Empire and its all-German constitutions of January 1, 1871 (BBZl. No. 16) and the constitution of August 11, 1919 (RRZL. I. p. 1383) and most recently organized from December 21, 2006 in the form of a new version of this constitution.

The new version of this original "Weimar Constitution" of August 11, 1919 (RRZL p. 1383) was dated December 19, 2006 (RRZL. Part 3, No. 2, 2006, pp. 8 - 41) by the from 1987 in Berlin under the direction of the Prussian legal consultant and Berlin Oberreichsbauer Dr. hc. Lawyer Wolfgang Gerhard Günter: [E b e l](#) established and approved by the Allies, the Commissar Reich Government was adopted and officially proclaimed.

The federal state and feudal Saxony-Meiningen go back to an Ernestine duchy.

It was originally created in 1680 when the Duchy of Saxe-Gotha was divided between the sons of Duke Ernst I of Saxe-Gotha (1601 - 1675).

The Duchy of Saxony-Meiningen had been a member of the German Confederation since 1815.

It received its own constitution on August 23, 1829.

In the German War of 1866, Saxony-Meiningen was on the side of Austria.

In 1871 the duchy and the state of Saxony-Meiningen became a member of the German Empire.

The Meiningen Duke Gerhard III. was abdicated on November 10, 1918. His half-brother and heir to the throne Ernst Erhard Viktor Prince of Saxe-Meiningen certified this on November 12, 1918.

However, this did not mean the collapse of the legitimate state of Saxony-Meiningen and all further developments did not lead to its downfall or complete legal abolition.

On the same day of November 12, 1918, the President of the Meiningen State Parliament, Eduard Fritze, nevertheless convened the Meiningen State Parliament, which was last elected in 1909. The so-called Free State of Saxony-Meiningen then took its course.

On December 30, 1918, Duke Gerhard III. a severance payment agreement was concluded regarding his ownership and financial situation.

From that moment on, the true state of Saxony-Meiningen fell into a long passive sleep phase.

A constitutional or other constitutional legitimation for the end of the respective Thuringian monarchies and



legitimate, imperial constitutional states can only be seen in the then more or less voluntary and individual request for resignation from the respective noble houses. However, as already indicated, the state of Saxony-Meiningen could not end there.

The Duchy of Saxony-Meiningen was therefore never dissolved and liquidated correctly, in accordance with the law and according to its own constitutional rules, as many textbooks and lawyers would have us believe today.

In the course of this history, however, the state and the area of Saxony-Meiningen as a whole developed into various similar and sometimes higher-level constructs, only at the beginning in the Free State of Saxony-Meiningen, which at least still had the same name.

However, from 1919 onwards this became part of the so-called Reichsland Free State of Thuringia with its own constitution.

Thuringia or the so-called Reichsland Free State of Thuringia goes back to the founding of April 20th and 30th, 1919, the proclamation on May 1st, 1920 and the all-German "Weimar Constitution" of April 11th, which came into being despite the chaos of war and at the emphatic demand of the Allies August 1919.

The Social Democrats, who have dominated since then, associated April 20th and 30th, 1919 and the proclamation on May 1st, 1920 as the "Day of Struggle of the Working Class".

Regarding the merger with the other Thuringian states to form the "State of Thuringia", which lasted in this form from 1920 to 1952, the state and the population took a wait-and-see approach and ultimately decided on a small Thuringian solution.

The supposedly constitutionally correct transfer of Saxony-Meiningen to the Reich Free State of Thuringia can, as described above, only be verified by means of "Reich Law".

On March 9, 1919, the election for a new Thuringian state parliament took place. In this event, the SPD received an absolute majority of votes. Nevertheless, the government of 1919 was confirmed in office on April 9, 1919 without any personnel changes.

Evil tongues claim that the existence of both the federal state and the Free State of Saxony-Meiningen as a sovereign duchy and constitutional state ended at the latest with the founding of the "State of Thuringia" on May 1, 1920. However, this is questioned here and, according to the available constitutional evidence, is also denied.

Interestingly, in the same autumn of 1920, the ultimately unsuccessful effort to "Lost Thuringia" emerged in some areas of Saxony-Meiningen.

The so-called "Law on the Administration of the Former Thuringian States in the Transitional Period" of December 9, 1920 finally converted the Free State into a higher-order municipal association in the Saxony-Meiningen area with regional representation and regional government, which was finally repealed on April 1, 1923. The state parliament was transformed into the regional administration without new elections.

There are significant legal continuity problems and legal subject identity problems in political developments and so-called political "new foundations". The new developments were and are probably never really legally binding in accordance with their own laws and regulations.

"The state of war of the First World War as a form of emergency and the conditions of foreign rule in the form of the "Weimar Republic", the "Third Reich", the "German Democratic Republic (DDR)" and the "BRD" have not ended to this day. The legitimate civil law of the state of Saxony-Meiningen could therefore not be further developed since the beginning of the war. There is also no legal subject identity and no legal continuity with the



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later founded "Free State of Saxony-Meiningen". This is a new establishment outside of state law. Thus, in the Duchy of Saxony-Meiningen we are in the legal status of July 30, 1914 with the constitution of August 23, 1829 and with the legal developments up to July 30, 1914." This view and assessment is still held today by many descendants of the old princely houses, as well as the Reich judge and current head of the Stafsenate, Dagmar Sybille from the Die tsch family, the presumably legitimate Prussian king or candidate for king Stefan, who was approved under the Commissary Imperial Government and by the Allies the Hohenzollern-Ratzeburg family, as well as the just-quoted Berlin psychiatrist, constitutional lawyer and self-declared mayor of Berlin in a state of emergency, Dr. Klaus from Leipzig from the M a u r e r family

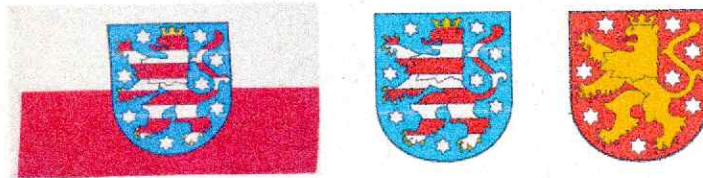
